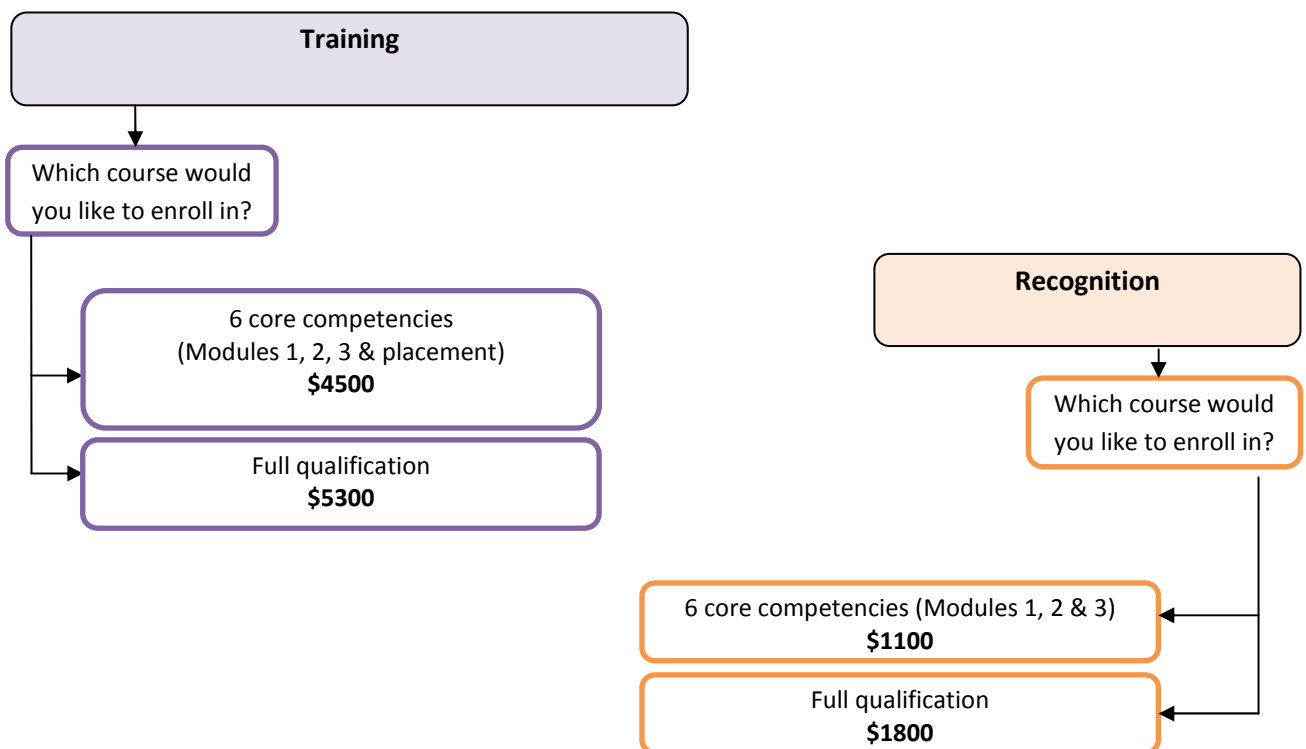


# FDR choices for people seeking accreditation as a FDR Practitioner
